

Kroger Community Rewards

You can help us raise funds simply by registering your Kroger Plus card and choosing our organization to benefit. If you do not already have a Kroger Plus card, they are available at the customer service desk of any Kroger store. They are free of charge and can ultimately save you money on many items, including fuel.

Kroger Community Rewards Program

Registering a card is easy to do:

Step 1 Register your Kroger Plus card by visiting www.krogercommunityrewards.com (if your card is already registered, proceed to Step 2)

- Select Cincinnati
- You must create an account on Kroger's website before you can register your card and link to KMCF/Women's Wellness Fund
- Do you use your phone number at the register?
Call 800-576-4377, select option 4 to get your Kroger Plus card number

Step 2: Sign up for a Kroger Rewards Account

- Click on Enroll
- If you are a new online customer, click on SIGN UP TODAY in the 'New Customer?' box.
- Enter your e-mail address
- Create a password
- Enter zip code
- Agree to the terms and conditions established by Kroger
- You will receive a message to check your e-mail inbox - click on the link within the body of the e-mail

Step 3 Click on "My account" and enter your e-mail and password

Step 4 Click on "Edit Kroger Community Rewards Information"

- You may need to input your Kroger Plus card number

Step 5 Update or confirm your information

Step 6 Enter "Kettering Medical Center Foundation" or our organization number: **82923**

- Women's Wellness Fund should appear - you will be asked to click and save

Kettering Medical Center Foundation's Women's Wellness Fund was initiated in 1995 and provides free screening and diagnostic mammograms, breast ultrasounds and prostheses to uninsured women (and men) in our community. It also provides education on breast cancer and other women's health issues through the Cindy Wilde Vogel Memorial Library located at the Kettering Breast Evaluation Center. Procedures may be scheduled at any KBEC facility and the Women's Wellness Fund will cover the cost.
